Built in 1921 for the Great Northern Railway to a design by Sir Nigel Gresley for use on suburban for use on suburban passenger trains out of London's King's Cross station, No. 1744 is owned. by the Gresley Society and based at the Great Central

CARPARK

GLYNDYFRDWA

The main car park for the 2012 Steel, Steam & Stars event is at Glyndyfrdwy. This is accessible from both east and west along the main A5 trunk road that runs parallel to the Llangollen Railway. Follow the signs from the A5 down the lane to Glyndyfrdwy station and over the level crossing turning right into the extensive car park

The car park charges a daily parking fee of £3.00. Please note that the car park adjacent to the Royal International Eisteddfod Pavilion is now a 'pay and display' car park and visitors using the facility will have to pay the advertised tariff

The nearest main line station is five miles from Llangollen at Ruabon (National Rail Tel: 08457 484950). We will be running an hourly bus shuttle service between Ruabon and Llangollen stations on both weekends. These will coincide with the hourly arrival/departure of Arriva Trains service at Ruabon. Friday and Saturday between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00pm and on Sundays between 10.00am and 6.00pm.

Bus services do operate to and from Llangollen from a variety of places. For information about routes and times Tel: 0870 6082608.


